

MEET YOUR MUSEUM

Interactive classroom presentations designed to introduce students and teachers to Phoenix Art Museum and what to expect when they visit.

Grades: 1st-8th

Length of Program: 50 minutes (can be modified to accommodate class schedule)

Program Description

Meet Your Museum presentations serve as an orientation to the Museum. Our goal is for students to arrive for their field trip eager to learn and excited to engage, with confidence that comes from knowing what to expect. Museum docents (volunteer educators) will visit your classroom to provide a preview for students, including:

- Orientation to Museum spaces and scope of the collection
- Introduction to basic Museum concepts and art vocabulary
- Strategies for looking, discussing, and making sense of art
- Overview of behavior expectations—museum etiquette

Classroom Requirements

- Screen or (light-colored wall) in a room that can be darkened for a PowerPoint presentation.
- Teacher must remain with class during presentation.
