Phoenix Art Museum and Contemporary Forum present art auction to benefit Museum exhibitions, educational programs

Museum support group Contemporary Forum will hold its annual art auction on January 27, 2018

PHOENIX (December 15, 2017) – On Saturday, January 27, Phoenix Art Museum will host [Contemporary Forum](#)'s annual art auction event. This year's auction, entitled [Going Once!](#), will take place beginning at 6 pm in the Museum's Cummings Great Hall. The event is Contemporary Forum's principal annual fundraiser, and all proceeds from the auction provide funding for Museum's contemporary art collection, for modern and contemporary exhibitions, and educational programs. The auction will feature nationally and locally recognized artists, including Shelia Pepe, Kehinde Wiley, Eric Fischl, and others.

Guests will have the opportunity to bid on paintings, sculptures, photography, and mixed-media works at a wide range of price points.
