Phoenix Art Museum announces early-bird ticketing for **PhxArt Amplified: Volume 2**, the second annual, audio-visual Museum takeover, happening January 20, 2019

The one-day only event features more than 30 performances of Arizona-based musical acts, installations, artists and more.



PHOENIX (September 17, 2019) – Sound and art converge once again at PhxArt Amplified: Volume Two, an all-day, all-ages audio-visual experience taking over Phoenix Art Museum on Sunday, January 20, 2019 from noon - 9:00 pm. Featuring a remarkable range of live, acoustic, and experimental performances throughout Museum galleries and spaces, PhxArt Amplified: Volume Two promises enhanced outdoor visual art installations and hands-on programming, an expansion of local musicians hailing from all around Arizona, and site-specific musical performances inspired by special exhibitions including *Teotihuacan: City of Water, City of Fire* and *Ragnar Kjartansson: Scandinavian Pain and Other Myths*. Guests will enjoy a variety of musical genres ranging from jazz, Latin, indie, pop, classical and more, along with a beer garden and a variety of food trucks. Last year, PhxArt Amplified: Volume One brought more than more than 1500 guests to the Museum to enjoy 8 hours of music and art performed by 30 acts consisting of nearly 100 artists.

Museum hours will be extended to 9:00 pm for the 2019 event. Tickets are free for Museum Members and children under 6.
